Last, BRICS Young Scientist Forum was hosted by Chelyabinsk, Russia in September 2020. In 2021, the conclave will be hosted by the National Institute of Advanced Studies, Bengaluru (NIAS), India through the Zoom platform. The Conclave will provide a high-level platform for academic and policy exchange among talented young scientists as well as scientific personnel from BRICS countries too.
