Dairy Farmers Training Programme at Randheja, Ta. Gandhinagar

The Directorate of Extension Education, Kamdhenu University, Gandhinagar organized "Scientific Animal Husbandry Training Programme" on 15th June, 2018 at Randheja, Ta. Gandhinagar. The programme was inaugurated in the august presence of Dr. P. H. Vataliya, Hon. Vice Chancellor, Kamdhenu University, Dr. Falguni Thakar, Additional Director, Department of Animal Husbandry, Gujarat, Dr. P. P. Patel, Project Officer, Kamdhenu University and Shri Jashubhai Patel, Sarpanch, Randheja. Total 185 dairy farm women had participated in the training programme.

In the inaugural speech, Dr. P. H. Vataliya said that for economic and social upliftment of the multitude of dairy farmers the need of the hour was systematic planning for renewed dairy growth. He also gave a formula for doubling the farmer's income by increasing productivity and reducing input cost. Dr. Falguni Thakar emphasized the need to work on breed improvement, balanced feed and improved hygiene. She also encouraged dairy farm women to pursue advanced animal husbandry practices to maximize their income and become self-reliant.

During technical session training lectures were given by Dr. V. S. Suthar, Dr. S. J. Vekariya, Dr. M. B.

Rajput and Dr. P. V. Jadav followed by question answer session and interaction with the dairy farm women. The training was mainly focussed on modern dairying, ration balancing, health, hygiene, artificial insemination and clean milk production about which dairy farm women got recent technical updates.

Training Programme on Animal Infertility Problems and Solution and Animal Infertility Camp at Chotasan Kampa

Directorate of Extension Education, Kamdhenu University organized "Dairy Farmers Training Programme on Animal Infertility Problems and Solution and Animal Infertility Camp" at Chotasan Kampa, Ta. Idar, Dist. Sabarkantha on 28th June, 2018.

The programme was inaugurated by Dr. P. H. Vataliya, Hon. Vice Chancellor, Kamdhenu University in the august presence of Dr. D.B. Patil, Director of Research, Dr. P.P. He advised dairy farmers to adopt scientific as well as organic animal husbandry practices and encouraged them to practice good hygienic methods of livestock keeping ensuring good quality of milk. Dairy Farmers have easy access to all type of veterinary healthcare, access to quality animal feed and many other services available in cooperative milk producers union and at Govt. veterinary clinics. Dr. D. B. Patil advised dairy farmers to refrain from adulteration of milk and motivated farmers to double the milk production by adopting scientific practices.

Kamdhenu University, Gandhinagar started Veterinary Hospital & Ambulatory Clinical Services:

The Postgraduate Institute of Veterinary Education & Research started a Veterinary Hospital at Rajpur (Nava), Himmatnagar in April-2018 and treated overall 350 cases since its inception. Veterinary Hospital is well-equipped with advanced diagnostic modalities such as Ultrasonography machine, X-ray, Portable Otoscope, Mobile Ultrasound Units, Electrocardiography machine, Multiparamonitors, Urine Analyzers, Advance Microscopes etc. A well-equipped Diagnostic & Research Laboratory has also been developed at PGIVER to provide rapid and accurate diagnostic services to animal owners. More than 732 biomaterials/samples have been collected and examined during April to June-2018. Along with this, University has also started Ambulatory Clinical Services in three villages (viz., Rajpur, Nava and Dhabal) nearby the campus on regular basis.
