Hon. Vice Chancellor, Kamdhenu University, Gandhinagar. Dr. P. H. Vataliya, Director of Extension Education and Dr. D. B. Patil, Director of Research, Kamdhenu University graced the programme as guest of honour. More than 170 dairy farm women had participated in the training programme.

In the inaugural speech Dr. P. H. Vataliya delineated the benefits of training programme to farmers and role of such training programmes in animal husbandry and women empowerment. He also emphasized on role of dairy farmers for development of dairy sector

Due to lack of financial support, they are unable to give quality fodder to their animals. Ultimately, this affects the quality of milk. Dr. P.H. Vataliya, Director of Extension Education underlined the importance of milk in human nutrition and acknowledged the vital role of dairy farmers in dairy development of the country. Dr. J. K. Patel advised and inspired dairy farmers to adopt organic animal husbandry practices and emphasized importance of clean milk production.

During technical session training lectures were given by Dr. S. J. Vekariya, Dr. C. M. Bhadesiya and Dr.M. B. Rajput followed by question answer session and interaction with the dairy farmers and farm women.
