Message

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1. NATIONAL SERVICE SCHEME (NSS)

The Department of Youth Affairs and Sports, Ministry of Human Resources Development, New Delhi, have started the National Service Scheme in 1969-70. The basic purpose of this scheme is to develop responsibility through social services and realization of work and discipline. National Service Scheme was functioning in all the colleges & Polytechnics of Kamdhenu University. During the year under report, volunteers registered for regular activity and for special camp are as under.

During the spare time of academic programme, the students are directly involved with the activities related to the problems and requirements of the society and its development through various fields of N.S.S. activities. They are also inspired to work with Environment, Health, Family welfare, Hospitals and other organizations during natural calamity for the benefit of society and work with people in the village and slums.

The social activities carried out by N.S.S. are divided in two groups i.e. Regular activities and Special Camp.

(1) Regular activities

NSS volunteer undertake various activities in campus adopted, villages and slumps for community service. Duration of these service is 120 hours ie. 20 hours for orientation of NSS volunteers, 30 hours for campus work and 70 hours for community service. In regular NSS programmes students undertake various activities in the college campuses, adopted villages, cities and slums during weekends. 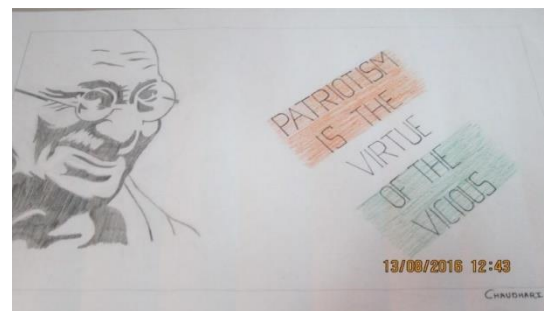


70th Independence Day at MIDFT, Mehsana

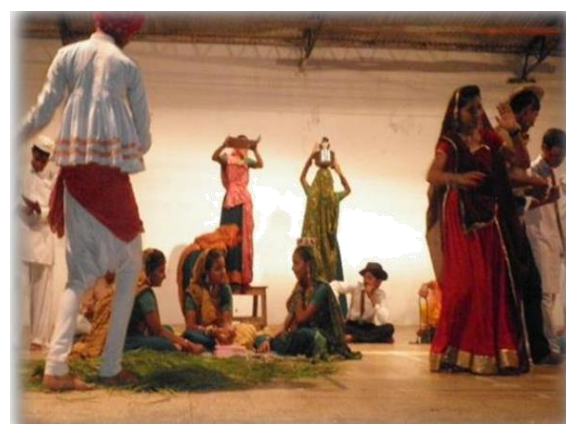
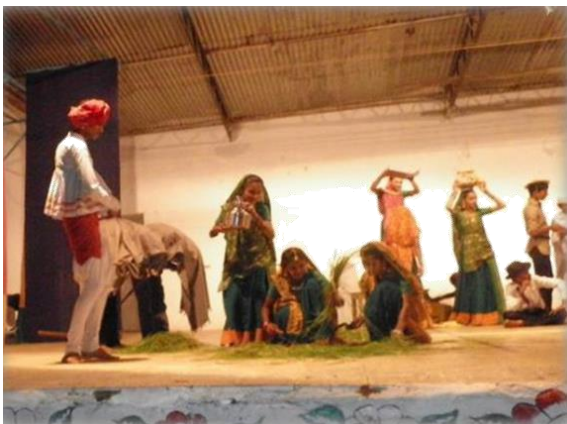
